Directions

I-680 North: Take Willow Pass Road exit, and turn left. Turn right onto Contra Costa Boulevard. At the second traffic light, turn left onto Golf Club Road and stay to the right when the road forks left. Drive through to the Country Club.

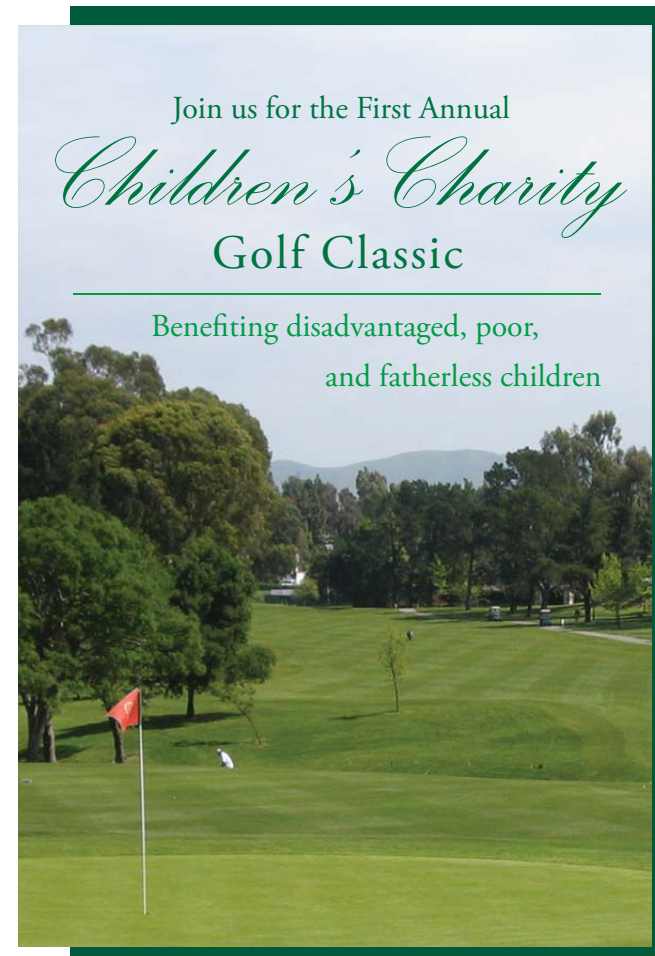
About The First Tee
