

Handicaps Now Available to The First Tee Participants



The United States Golf Association Handicapping System enables golfers of all ages to compete on an equitable basis. To establish a handicap you must be a member of a golf club. Once a player posts ten adjusted scores, the NCGA issues the player a handicap index.

The Northern California Golf Association is now offering handicap GHIN indexes to participants of The First Tee at a significantly discounted rate of \$2 per year. The First Tee of Contra Costa will pay \$1 of annual fee and asks the participant to pay \$1.

Through the generosity of the Concord Men's and Women's Golf Clubs, The First Tee of Contra Costa is now able offer handicaps to all of our participants. Our club designation is The First Tee of Contra Costa Youth on Course. We have separate boys and girls club designation number.

To get started include the \$1 fee with your Spring Session participant fee or contact Vic Morris at Diablo Creek Golf Course. Some participants have already received their GHIN card & number. To post scores please bring scorecards with score, date played, which tees you played from and turn into Vic at Diablo Creek Golf Course or Pat Cain at Lone Tree Golf Course. Scorecards can be turned in from last year. Scorecards that have already been turned in by participants have been posted.
